ECIA's Lead Paint & Healthy Homes program utilizes federal funds to provide financial assistance to low and moderate income homeowners and rental property owners to reduce lead based paint hazards in homes with young children that reside in the home or visit.

Homes and rental units built before 1978 are eligible for funds.

- There is no cost to a homeowner or renter.
- The program spends an average of \$25,000 per property.
- Improvements are also made to the home to make it healthier and safer. Some projects have received new windows, siding, radon remediation, bathroom exhaust fans and smoke detectors, for example.
- If repairwork requires relocation, the program pays for hotel accommodations.
